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THE HOSPITALITY GROUP FUNERAL INSURANCE SCHEME HAS BEEN SPECIFICALLY DESIGNED FOR THE HOSPITALITY INDUSTRY AND IS COMPULSORY ACCORDING TO CLAUSE 21B OF THE COLLECTIVE AGREEMENT PUBLISHED IN GOVERNMENT GAZETTE NO 50609 DATED 03 MAY 2024.



According to clause 21B of the Collective Agreement published in the Government Gazette No. 50609 dated 03 May 2024. membership is compulsory for all full-time employees under normal retirement age within the scope and sector of the Bargaining Council of the Restaurant, Catering and Allied Trades.

Compulsory membership of the hospitality group funeral insurance scheme no: 4151686104. Refer to clause 21B of the Collective Agreement published in the Government Gazette No 50609 dated 03 May 2024.

BASIC COVER

A cash benefit is payable on the death of a member, spouse or child before the member's normal retirement age, provided that the relevant requirements are complied with.

Children 14 years up to 21 years	R 18 500
Children 6 years and older but under 14 years	R 9 000
Children 1 year and older but under 6 years	R 4 500
Miscarriage from 26 weeks, stillborn and children less than 1 year	R 4 500
Premium per member	R 25
